

### **The China Visa Process - Wendy Wu Tours – Transcript –**

Hi, I'm Ellen and I'm an Operations Executive here at Wendy Wu Tours and this video is about the China visa process.

Now I know visas can be quite daunting for a lot of people but fortunately if you've booked a fully inclusive group tour with us then the visa service is included.

About 10 weeks before departure we will reach out to you or via your travel agent with the start of the process. What happens is you'll need to fill in an online form which we provide a comprehensive help sheet for and submit this online. Once it is approved you will print and post it along with your physical passport to our visa agents. You will not need to attend the visa centre in person for fingerprints as our visa partners can do this for you. Once the visa has been obtained they will send it back to you via special delivery and then you are all good to go.

Now this is based off British passport holders. Other passport holders who may be eligible to be visa free will be contacted. Some people will be able to travel on a visa on arrival. Again eligible customers will be contacted regarding this.

Now this process is ever changing so we will contact you between 2 to 3 months before departure via email with the current process and exactly what you need to do next.
